- Palette knife
- Paint rags/paper towels
- Also...bug spray, water for drinking, snacks, sun screen, layered clothing, good walking shoes, visored hat

***For Oil painting students:*** Students interested in deepening their understanding of light effects and color should have an impressionist range of colors.

- Cadmium yellow light or lemon, cadmium orange and/or red.
- Permanent rose(Winsor & Newton good)
- Permanent magenta and/or alizarin crimson
- French ultramarine blue
- Cerulean blue
- Yellow ochre
- Burnt sienna
- Winsor & Newton makes a beautiful transparent indian yellow for earth tones with sun.
- Big tube of white titanium zinc mix is good.

***For Pastel students:***

- MiTientes dark or grey pastel paper is a good economical pastel paper. (Can be found at Ace Hardware in Provincetown).
- Set of 30, 45 or 90 Rembrandt pastels (Half stick boxes are good and economical)
- Lightweight Drawing board.

***For Watercolor students:***

- Good watercolor paper, an Arches block or similar makes painting easier. You can buy student colors but good paper allows much more room for experimentation and changes
- Flat brush -big strokes are fun.
- A good range of colors
- Cadmium yellow light or lemon
- Cadmium orange and/or red
- Permanent rose(Winsor & Newton good)
- Permanent magenta and/or alizarin crimson, French
- Ultramarine blue
- Cerulean blue
- Yellow ochre
- Burnt sienna
- Winsor & Newton makes a beautiful transparent indian yellow for earth tones with sun.
