- Pencil sharpener or pocket knife
- Camp stool or portable seat
- French Easel or Portable easel (Castle Hill has a limited number of easels to borrow - call to reserve)
- Your own paint kit, or:
 - Palette
 - Bristle brushes of good quality such as Windsor Newton or Isabey (I use #4 and #8 filberts, #2 and #4 flats)
 - Palette knife
 - Windsor Newton colors:
 - alizarin crimson
 - winsor blue
 - red shade
 - Rembrandt oil colors:
 - cadmium yellow light
 - cadmium yellow medium
 - yellow ochre
 - cadmium orange
 - cadmium red medium
 - cadmium red deep
 - french ultramarine deep
- Windsor Newton Liquin Original (medium)
- mineral spirits and can with lid for mineral spirits
- 3-5 stretched canvases of your choice of size (try 8x10, 9x11, 12x16)
