## Cape Landscape Painting

**Location: Edgewood Farm, 3 Edgewood Way, Truro**

### **Please bring with you to class:**

- Paint: Oil paint is preferred but acrylic is fine. Recommended colors:
  - Titanium white
  - Cadmium yellow medium
  - Yellow ochre
  - Burnt sienna
  - Cadmium red medium
  - Alizarin crimson (or equivalent)
  - Cobalt blue
  - Ultramarine blue
  - Permanent green
  - Viridian green
  - Ash black.
- A variety of round and flat bristle brushes ranging from large to small
- Recommended canvas size: from 9"x 12" up to 16" x 20"
- Three coats of gesso on masonite, heavy weight paper or panel are all suitable painting surfaces, as is canvas boards or stretched canvas.
- A container for cleaning brushes with a tight lid (a coffee can works well for this) and a screen of some sort placed in the bottom of the can to create a barrier between the gunk that settles to the bottom and your brushes. - A portable easel (Castle Hill has a limited number available to borrow - call to reserve.)
- A palette and palette knife
- Rags
- Insect repellent, sunscreen, hat, water
