Please bring with you to class:

- Oils, acrylics, watercolor, or gouache (any medium is fine, as long as you are working with some kind of paint, using color and brushes)
- Palette knife and portable palette
- Medium for water based medium watercolor blocks are good, or turpentine/gamsol for oils, etc.
- Brushes, be sure to bring BIG brushes
- Rags
- A portable easel or drawing board w/ portable chair
- Several Masonite (untampered if possible, very hard to find these days) or wood panels, canvas boards, or stretched canvasses – gessoed. Bring several supports of choice, students might be producing multiple studies and paintings each day
- Wear old clothes, and bring a hat with a brim
