- An apron
- Drawings of your own, or images you wish to make into prints. 3-4 images to fit onto 4 x 5" blocks; 1-3 images to fit 8 x 10" blocks. We can work with other images sizes by cutting blocks down.
- Sketchbook of lightweight paper for working on drawings and transferring drawings to blocks.
- Pencils, soft and hard
- Black ink markers (sharpie-like)
- Wood and/or linoleum cutting tools, if possible. Several types of carving tools will be introduced in class
- Optional: spatula for handling inks; brayers for rolling out ink; wooden spoon or other burnishing tool.
