- Copper objects from home or thrift stores to patina (optional)

Useful *if* you have them (instructor will provide for shared use by class):

- Jeweler's saw & blades (#2/0)
- Dremel tool with drill bits and attachments
- Assorted jeweler's or beader's pliers
- Hand files (for metal)
- Ball peen or chasing hammer

Note: \$30 materials fee, included in tuition, applies to materials that the instructor will be bringing to the workshop:

- A kit including copper sheet and wire, patina manual, sawblades and earplugs.
- Materials for making/applying patinas
- Hand tools for forming metal, etc. will be available for shared use by the class.
