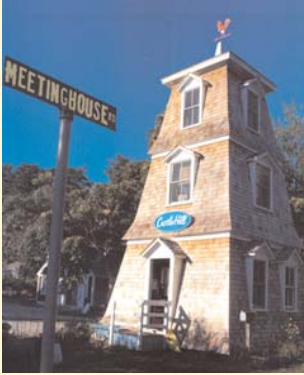


WHAT IS CASTLE HILL?

Since 1971, the Truro Center for the Arts at Castle Hill has been a vibrant cultural center on Cape Cod. We present a variety of highly acclaimed cultural arts programs including an extensive school of the arts, exhibitions, events and programs for the community. Castle Hill provides opportunities for artists to create, exhibit, perform, teach and learn.



WORKSHOPS

Throughout its history, Castle Hill has offered visitors and residents a wide array of art instruction taught by an impressive group of faculty and visiting artists. Our offerings are

multi-disciplinary and span the visual, literary and craft arts.

- Notable faculty has included Alan Dugan, Joan Snyder, Helen Frankenthaler, Wil Barnett, Judy Pfaff, Faith Ringgold, Yevgeny Yevtushenko and Mary Frank to name but a few.

- Visiting lecturers and teachers

include Nobel Prize winners Saul Bellow and Derek Wolcott, news journalist Morton Dean, author Mary Gordon, British surgeon Iain Hutchinson, Pulitzer Prize winning poet Mary Oliver, US Poet Laureates Robert Pinsky and Billy Collins.

- Each year, Castle Hill serves approximately 800 adults and children from across the country who enroll in our summer classes. These numbers continue to increase.



FACTS ABOUT CASTLE HILL

- Each year, Castle Hill employs over 150 artists. 35% are year-round Cape Cod residents. 26% are from Truro or Provincetown.
- Our students spend approximately \$480,000 in Truro and Provincetown on housing during July and August.
- We began offering year-round workshops for the local community in 2003 when the Annex at Pamet Crossing was purchased.
- Castle Hill helped to preserve an endangered species, the *Pamet Puma*, which can be seen on the gym wall in the Truro Central School.
- Castle Hill restored its iconic windmill tower last year. Currently we are restoring the historic 1882 barn with funds from the Truro Community Preservation Committee, the Massachusetts Cultural Facilities Fund and local individuals and foundations.
- Castle Hill accomplishes its programs and events through a small committed staff, a dedicated Board of Directors and a devoted group of volunteers.

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS

- A free "Artist in the Schools" program for students from Provincetown to Orleans.
- A free "Art for Seniors" program during the month of September for local senior citizens in painting, printmaking, poetry and clay.
- A Friday after-school program for kids at a reduced price.
- The first Printmaking Cooperative and the only Ceramics Cooperative on Cape Cod, providing local artists with access to our studios and equipment during the off-season.
- This year, through a partnership with Highlands Center Inc., Castle Hill will manage and maintain the first wood-fired kiln on Cape Cod.



COMMUNITY SERVICES

- Scholarships to all area schools for any student interested in learning in the visual arts.
- Scholarships specifically for Truro students, offered through the Michael Rice Scholarship fund & Truro Treasures.
 - A work/study program for anyone who can't afford to take classes.
- Scholarships to clients of the AIDS Support Group of Cape Cod.

July 8 - **Caroline Rand Herron**, Former Staff Editor of *The New York Times Book Review*.

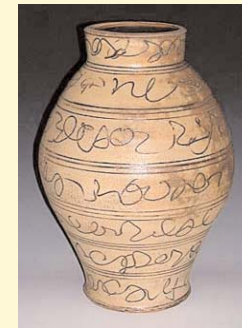
July 15 - **Anthony Walton**, author of "*Mississippi: An American Journey*" and historian and scholar of African American history.
