## Please bring with you to class:

- Small lightweight portable easel (optional)
- Folding field stool (recommended)
- 4B graphite pencil
- Water soluble graphite pencil (dark)
- 4B soft charcoal pencil
- Fountain pen with blue or black ink cartridge or felt tipped water-soluble pen (Tombow brand)
- Pencil sharpener or exacto knife
- Field sketch pad approx. 9"x12"
- Watercolor Block approx. 9"x12" ("Fluid" brand is inexpensive) or loose sheets 140lb
- Medium sized watercolor brushes (filberts and flats nice)
- Gouache or watercolor paint (Ideal colors: Titanium white, Alizarin crimson, Cadmium red medium, Cadmium yellow light, Lemon yellow, Cerulean, Ultramarine Blue, Burnt Umber), and/or small Travel Watercolor box 8-12 colors
- WC palette
- Thin white artists (painters) tape
- Viewfinder (plastic adjustable grey or we can make your own)
- White eraser
- Variety of assorted solid colored papers: small sheets of Canson paper, Color Aid, origami papers, handmade papers &/or construction papers
- Glue
- Scissors
- Container for water
- Backpack to carry supplies
- Also...bug spray, water for drinking, snacks, sun screen, layered clothing, good walking shoes, visored hat, paper towels/rags.
