Materials fee: \$20 due by first day of class

Materials List (what students should bring to class):

- PANELS:
 - o 3-4 wood panels (up to 12"x 12"): <https://www.jerrysartarama.com/art/Unprimed-Wood-Panels> (Est. cost \$45-\$65)
 - o Alternatively, you could get plywood from the hardware store and cut it down to 12"x12" panels
- BRUSHES:
 - o 2-3 natural hair brushes of various sizes. No synthetic brushes ~ they will melt! (Est. cost \$8-10)
 - o You can purchase flat chip brushes of varying sizes (1", 2", 3", 4") from your local hardware store: <https://www.homedepot.com/s/flat%20chip%20brush?NCNI-5>
- OPTIONAL for collage/mixed media:
 - o Thin, absorbent (uncoated) materials - gift wrap tissue, collage papers, party napkins, doilies, lace
 - o Dried, organic objects (ash, coffee grounds, fully-dried pressed flowers or leaves)
 - o For image transfers (laser prints only): Small black/white images printed with a laser printer. If your image contains text, please flip it horizontally before printing so the text appears backwards.

Materials fee of \$20 covers materials (listed below)

Castle Hill and sponsors will provide the following items:

- Encaustic paint and medium
- Rags, blue tape, gloves
- Heat palettes, heat guns, torches, irons and other equipment
- Newsprint, oil, and other cleaning supplies

Instructor will provide the following:

- Pan pastels, mark making tools (woodies/salon pas/crayons), stamps/inks, collage papers, tacking iron & encaustic pen to (For demo and the group to share)
