Please bring with you to class:

- **Canvas:**

Please bring at least 5 assorted sizes from 9x12, 11x14, 12x16 up to 16x20. We will work on a different canvas every day.

A small sketchbook and pencil or charcoal.

- Medium and Solvent, I like gamsol.

- **SUGGESTED OIL COLORS:** If you already have lots of paint, please don't feel like you have to buy more.

Bring what you already have. These colors are suggested ONLY.

- Cerulean Blue
- Cobalt Blue
- Ultramarine Blue
- Sap green
- Viridian or terre verte
- Olive green
- Raw umber
- Yellow ochre
- Cadmium yellow pale or lemon yellow
- Cadmium yellow
- Cadmium red or cadmium scarlet
- Alizarin crimson
- Transparent oxide red
- Titanium white

- Paper Towels, Wipes and Trash Bag (I recommend VIVA. They are absorbent and similar to cloth.)

- Palette and Portable Easel

- **Brushes:**

Please bring a variety of sizes, large (1" at least) and medium sizes, bristle and soft. Flats, filberts and brights. Your choice. I particularly like Rosemary & Company brushes. You can find them at

Rosemarybrushes.com but they are not required. I also like Robert Simmons Titanium brushes in a variety of sizes, flats and filberts.

- Palette Knife
- **And most importantly:** HAT, SUNSCREEN, BUG SPRAY, UMBRELLA , closed shoes
