Please bring with you to class:

For Outdoor Drawing/sketching

- At least 4 sketchbooks of various sizes, paper weights, and formats to experiment with. Opt for sketchbooks with thick enough paper to accommodate water-based media
- Bulldog clips for securing paper or pages while working outdoors
- A variety of drawing materials including: pencils, charcoal, pens, and colored drawing media such as watercolor, oil or soft pastels, acrylic inks, felt pens or water-soluble sticks. Consider including a small tube of white gouache for opacity and bring along a brush for water-soluble materials.
- 6-8 Wood cradled or un-cradled panels such as Ampersand, Encausticbord, Claybord, wood, plywood, or any other wood panels. Recommended sizes include a few 8"x8" for trial boards, and a few 10"x10" or 12"x12" for larger works
- Natural bristle brushes in 1" and 2" sizes
- An apron
- Paper or bubble wrap for packing paintings

Materials Fee of \$15 covers the tools, paint, equipment and other encaustic supplies provided by Castle Hill.
