Silkscreen Monoprint with Encaustic

Materials fee: \$60 due by first day of class

Materials List (what students should bring to class):

- 10 sheets of Stonehenge paper 22 x 30 (preferably white or tan)
- 1 small watercolor set (inexpensive set is fine)
- 1 set of Caran D'ache Neocolor crayons set of 15
- 2 sheets of stiff cardboard (20 x 24)
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 3 Mr Clean Magic Erasers
- 1 Newsprint Pad, 50 sheets 18 x 24
- 3 or 4 small to larger brushes for waterbed materials
- A set of brushes used for encaustic

Materials fee of \$60 covers materials (listed below)

Castle Hill and sponsors will provide the following items:

- Encaustic paint and medium
- Rags, blue tape, gloves
- Heat palettes, heat guns, torches, irons and other equipment
- Newsprint, oil, and other cleaning supplies
