## **Encaustic with Photo Collage**

Location: Main Campus, 10 Meetinghouse Road, Truro Materials fee: \$35 pre-pay online, or on the first day of class

## Materials List (what students should bring to class):

- 6 8 wood cradled or un-cradled panels: Ampersand, Encaustibord, Blick Premium Wood panels; any size unprimed, as many fit in your suitcase!
- 8 10 Natural bristle brushes: different sizes, flat, filbert, and round
- Apron: to protect clothing
- Collage materials: fabric, charcoal, chalk or oil pastels: for drawing/painting on the panel before adding wax
- 2 metal palette knives in different sizes: 1 1/2" 5" wide
- basic tools: scissors, pencil, exacto knife
- scraping tools: dental tools or clay tools for incising
- laser or Xerox copies: image transfers
- Optional: Recycled tin cans (like tuna/cat food etc.) flat and shallow for mixing paint
- Optional: bring heat gun if you have one

## Images

- 2 images are included in the supply fee
  - Please send high contrast black and white or color images to Jodi@jodireeb.com via email by May 25<sup>th</sup>
  - . These will be printed ahead of time and brought to the workshop
- Additional images are \$10 each image print area of 12" x 18"
- It is recommended that your image size match the outside dimension of your substrates (horizontally or vertically) as a jpeg file at 150dpi
- Black and white or color is best as a <u>high contrast image</u> with lights and darks vs. grey/mid-tones without small details. Think of ways you will add color and/or texture to your image
