Materials List (what students should bring to class):

- Wax Paper
- Blue painters tape
- Tracing paper
- A pear-shaped loop tool
- Assorted natural bristle brushes, and a minimum of (1 each) 1", 2", 3" Flat hake brushes
- Drawing materials – sharpie marker pen, regular and thin
- Value study materials: **Dual Tip Grayscale Alcohol Marker Set** (min set of 12)
Brands: Tombow Alcohol Markers, Arteza Alcohol Markers, or Arrtx Alcohol Markers
- Sketchbook "lay flat" for value exercises
Suggested: Strathmore 300 series multi-media Pad, Size 9"x12" or 11"x14"
- 3-4 Primed encaustic panels, suggested sizes 8"x10", 10 x10" or similar, no larger than 12" x 12"

Materials fee of \$45 covers materials (listed below) provided by Castle Hill, instructor, and sponsors.

Castle Hill and sponsors will provide the following items:

- Encaustic paint and medium
- Rags, blue tape, gloves
- Heat palettes, heat guns, torches, irons
- Newsprint, oil, and other cleaning supplies

Instructor will provide the following:

- Printed value tool charts and substrates for creating your own
- View finders
- Heat resistant duralar polyester film sheets
- Transfer paper
