# Cyanotype Printmaking & Encaustic Instructor: Michele Randall

Monday - Tuesday June 5 - 6 2 Sessions 10am - 4pm

**Location:** Edgewood Farm, 3 Edgewood Way, Truro

Materials fee: \$30 due by first day of class

### Materials List (what students should bring to class):

- Hake brushes
- Simple Black and white images printed on regular copy paper. Any type of printer will work for this process. High contrast, with simple outlines and/or minimal backgrounds will work best.
- (Optional) Extra materials for photograms such as lace, stencils, small flat objects from nature.
- (Optional) Any special pan pastels colors or oil sticks for enhancing the encaustic work.
- There will be time spent outdoors in the sun so bring a hat and sunscreen!

## Materials fee of \$30 covers materials (listed below)

Castle Hill and sponsors will provide the following items:

- Encaustic paint and medium
- Rags, blue tape, gloves
- Heat palettes, heat guns, torches, irons and other equipment
- Newsprint, oil, and other cleaning supplies

## *Instructor will provide the following:*

- Chemicals and papers for the complete cyanotype printmaking experience.
- Use of hardware and tools for the exposure process. (This will include chemical solutions, hardware for exposure process, a range of paper substrates)
- Finishing and mark making tools
- Encaustic medium and design tools.
- Additional finished cyanotype papers and collage materials for experimentation.
- Mark-making elements and finishing materials for the second day of class.
- Each student will receive:
  - 10 sheets of prepared cyanotype paper
  - 1 sheet acetate for image transfer
  - 1 8 x 10" board for encaustic work
