Please bring with you to class:

- **Brushes:**
 - #2, #3, #6 flat hog bristle
 - Small round synthetic
 - 1" flat brush
- **Paint Colors:**
 - French ultramarine blue
 - Cerulean blue
 - Cadmium red light
 - Alizarin crimson
 - Cadmium yellow light
 - Lemon Yellow
 - Yellow ochre
 - Raw umber
 - Titanium White – Large tube
- **Canvas:** *Please do not bring canvas panels or smooth surface panels*
 - **(1)** 16" x 20"
 - **(4)** 12" x 16"
- **Other Materials:**
 - Bristol paper pad 11x14" (300 series is a good choice)
 - Palette (paper palettes are ok but not recommended for oil paints)
 - Palette knife

 - Vine charcoal (one stick)

- Baby or hand wipes (to remove the paint off your hands and face)
 - Paper towels
 - Jars to clean brushes
 - Palette cups (2) to dip your brushes while painting
 - Roll of kitchen wax paper
 - Masking tape
 - Optional: Empty cardboard box to take wet paintings home
- **For OIL PAINTERS ONLY:**
 - Odorless paint thinner (gamsol)
 - Jar with cover to take dirty paint thinner home for disposal
 - Clear-wrap paper to cover your palette overnight

*****We are sorry but you cannot put contaminated liquids down the drains or dump any materials on Castle Hill premises. All cleaning products and contaminated liquid - paint water, solvents, etc. - need to go home with you.***
