NOTE: Materials fee of \$25 included in the cost of the workshop provides consumable materials for the class. Below is a list of what students should bring with them.

Please bring with you to class:

- Apron: waterproof is best if you don't want to be soaked. Whatever is comfortable.
- Scissors
- Hand towel
- Pencils
- Pad for taking notes and labeling your paper
- Flat cardboard and blotter or large drawing pad for taking home wet sheets to stay flat
Any cardboard will do, cut up boxes, just big (pref 18 x 24 or close to that size)
- An inexpensive drawing pad of acid free paper to help dry your paper.
- Fibers that you'd like to experiment with, Iris leaves, cattail fluff, onion skins,
- Items for inclusions, paper, prints, thread, ribbon, stones, seaweed, flower petals, buttons, basketry materials... (these are purely optional)
- Shoes that can get wet
- Hat for the sun
- Ideas about journeys and pathways, your own migration or that of your favorite birds. Inner journeys that inspire visual sketches or symbols. Memories of transformation. An open mind.
